Under the Localism Act 2011, councillors cannot participate in discussions where they have a disclosable pecuniary interest (DPI). They must also declare any non-pecuniary interests in any matters on the agenda of a Council meeting. Councillors can apply for a DPI dispensation to speak and/or vote at a meeting where matters relating to their interest are being discussed. Such applications must be submitted to the proper officer and agreed by the council or relevant committee.
