



TENNIS COURT – PLAYERS’ RULES

Opening hours

- The court is available daily during daylight hours. You need a booking to play.
- To access the Hallmaster online booking system please scan the QR code or go to our website at www.westhorsley-pc.gov.uk.



Behaviour

- No glass allowed on the tennis court or in the players’ hut.
- Alcohol, smoking and chewing gum are not permitted on any part of the playing area.
- Dogs are not allowed on the tennis court.
- No cycling on the tennis court.
- Users must dispose of any rubbish or waste materials.
- Aggressive or abusive behaviour to any other users will not be tolerated and may result in a ban from future use of the facility.
- Deliberate damage to the players’ hut and/or playing area will be reported to the Police.

Court Condition

- West Horsley Parish Council is committed to ensuring the tennis court is available for community use. However, individual users have the responsibility to ascertain whether it is safe to use the courts – factors for this include, but are not limited to, the prevailing weather conditions.
- It is the booker’s responsibility to ensure that all those playing tennis are made aware of the fact that they do so in all respects at their own risk.
- Before commencing play, please ensure that you are wearing appropriate, clean footwear and that the court is clear of any debris such as leaves and twigs. This helps in keeping the court in optimal condition, making the playing experience as good as possible.

First Aid

- It is the individual’s own responsibility to make their own first aid arrangements, such as the provision of a first aid kit, there is no legal requirement for the Parish Council to provide first aid facilities.

Equipment

- Tennis shoes must be worn at all times whilst on court.
- It is the users’ responsibility to provide their own racquets and balls.

Loss of Property

- The Parish Council cannot accept responsibility for damage to, or the loss or theft of, players’ property.

Car Parking

- Cars are parked at the owner’s risk. Please do not block access to Horsley Football Club. Please be considerate of other road users when parking on Long Reach.
