Licence Application for Hammonds Glamping, Lower Hammonds Farm, Ripley Lane, West Horsley, KT24 6JP

Summary of Licence Application:

To sell/supply alcohol:

Monday to Saturday: 12 noon to 11pm

Sunday: 12 noon to 10.30pm

Provision of Films (using portable cinema screens to provide cinema showings):

Monday to Saturday: 7pm to 11pm

Sunday: 7pm to 10.30pm

Special events:

Live music and recorded music with DJ: Monday to Sunday 10am to 11pm

Possible dance workshops or performance: Monday to Sunday 10am to 11pm

Recommendation from the Planning Committee:

It is recommended that the Parish Council submits a representation requesting either that the application be amended to reflect the applicant's stated intentions (to hold a small number of public events alongside the seasonal glamping business) or that appropriate and enforceable conditions are imposed by the Licensing Sub-Committee.

The objective of the Parish Council's response is to prevent public nuisance. Whilst the applicant's disturbance-reduction measures are welcomed, including headphones for silent cinema, these do not apply to live bands, DJs or other amplified entertainment. Residents have expressed concern about noise from the site which indicates the risk of public nuisance is realistic. No detailed noise management measures are proposed, such as a noise management plan, speaker controls, monitoring, or complaints procedure and these need to be considered prior to consideration of a licence involving music (live or recorded).

The application is broader than the stated intentions (a small number of public events alongside seasonal glamping). It would permit alcohol sales, live music, recorded music and dance performances until 11.00pm every day. The application lacks enforceable limits on the number, frequency, attendance or season of special events.
